

Entry Criteria for JCs

Core Requirements focus on strong literacy and numeracy:

- Min of Grade 6 for <u>English</u>
- Min of Grade 7 for <u>MTL</u> / Grade 8 for <u>Higher MTL</u>
- Min of Grade 7 for <u>Mathematics</u>

L1R5 Aggregate: must not exceed 20 points for 6 subjects only.

- L1: English or Higher MTL
- <u>R</u>elevant 1: Humanities
- <u>Relevant 2: Math/Science</u>
- <u>R</u>elevant 3: Math/Science/Humanities
- <u>Relevant 4 &5: Remaining 2 Best subjects (except CCA)</u>

Aim to score in 5 content-based subjects to maximise chances for JC.



Entry Criteria for Polytechnics

General Requirements focus on strong literacy and numeracy:

- Min Grade 6 for English and
- Min Grade 6 for Mathematics for most courses

L1R2B2 Aggregate: MUST not exceed <u>26 points</u> (28 points for Diploma in Nursing).

- L1: English
- R2: Relevant 2 subjects with a minimum C6 grade based on the course that you want (varies from course to course)
- B2: Best 2 subjects

Aim to score in 4 content-based subjects to maximise chances for Poly.

To qualify for	You need to have demonstrated your ability at Sec 2:			
Pure Science (Double/Triple)	At least 60% for Sec 2 Science EYE If opting for triple science: allowed to choose only one Humanities subject so they must have at least 60% for Sec 2 Humanities EYE			
Double Humanities	At least 60% for Sec 2 Humanities EYE			
Additional Maths 3 Exp	At least 60% for Sec 2 Math EYE			



Subject Requirements for Coursework Subjects

Eligible for	Minimum Criteria (based on overall result)
Art ('O' Level)	 Pass an Art Aptitude Test
All subjects	Min of 5 students to open the class



Streaming Considerations

- All our subject combinations allow students to gain entry to JCs or Polytechnics.
- Your daughter's Sec 1 and 2 results are a good way to determine the best match of subject combinations for her.
 Be realistic and focused on finding her interests and strengths.
- At Sec 2, know the criteria for each subject combination and work towards your preferred combination.
- At Sec 3, understand JC and Polytechnic requirements and strategise how you will achieve the necessary results.



Major Considerations

Setting our students up for success:

- Choose the best combination for your child in her upper secondary years, based on BOTH her interest and ability.
- Work with her to obtain the best aggregate possible (L1R5, L1R2B2) to progress to the most suitable post-secondary course of her choice.





Subject Option Process

Application by Students

 Represents preference and assessment of strengths and weaknesses by students and parents

Placement by School

- Professional assessment of strengths & weaknesses based on students' performed results,
- Based on teachers' knowledge of student's ability and attitude in learning
- Applies meritocratic principle when places are limited by using overall score & strengths in relevant subjects.



Subject Option Process

- Students will submit their confirmed and final subject choices by 24 October 2024, 5 pm via Subject Option Student Portal.
- Choices should be made carefully, endorsed with both parent's and student's signatures. There should be no change after submission.
- 3. Upon release of results on 5 Nov 2024, 12 noon, students and parents may proceed to purchase subject materials for 2025.
