



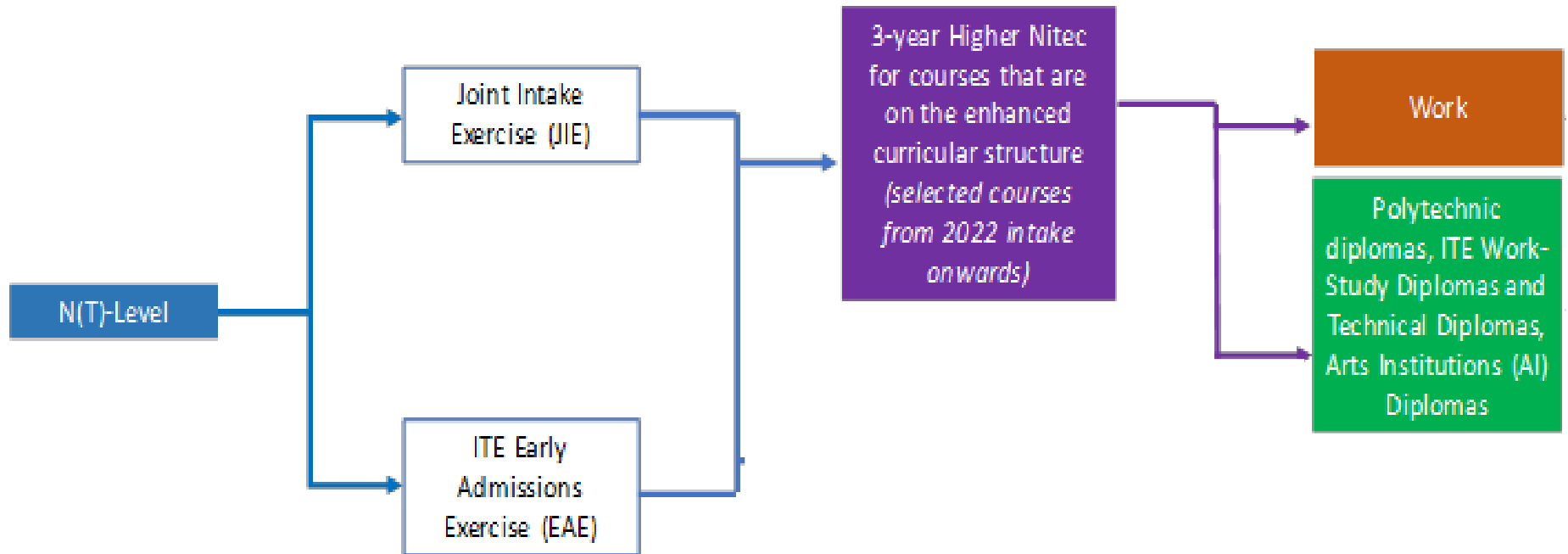

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Paths you can progress to after 'N'-Level Examinations

Overview of progression pathways for N(T) students leading to work-ready qualifications



After the N-Level Examinations, students can take part in

- **Joint Intake Exercise (JIE)**

Students who have taken N-Level examinations can apply directly to the Institute of Technical Education (ITE).

Options	Who is it for?	More Information
<u>3-Year Higher Nitec Course</u>	NT students who have completed their N-Level examinations .	ITE is on track to transit all current 2-year Nitec courses to an enhanced 3-year curricular structure leading to a Higher Nitec certification by AY2026.
<u>3-Year Nitec Course</u> with Enhanced Nitec Foundation Programme	NT students who have obtained ≤ 1 N-Level pass.	Students will undergo 2 years of Enhanced Nitec Foundation Programme before progressing to the Career Core curriculum in Year 3.



After the ITE courses, there are more pathways too.

After ITE, where can you progress to?

GPA of **3.5** – Progress to Diploma at Polytechnic

- From AY2027, polytechnic admission is **guaranteed** to all Higher Nitec students with GPA of 3.5 or higher.

GPA of **2.5** - Minimum entry requirement to Polytechnic

GPA of **3.0** – Progress to Technical Diploma at ITE

Progress to Work Study Diploma at ITE

	Subject option for 3NT
Subj 1 to 5	English Language + Basic Mother Tongue + Mathematics Syllabus T + Computer Applications (CPA) + Science
Subj 6	Elements of Business Skills (EBS) OR Nutrition & Food Science (NFS) OR Music



Criteria for some subjects

Eligible for	Minimum Criteria (based on overall result)
Music N(T)	Pass the Music Selection Test
All subjects	Min of 5 students to open the class



Subject option process

Application by Students

- Represents preference and assessment of strengths and weaknesses by students and parents

Placement by School

- **Professional** assessment of strengths & weaknesses based on students' performed results,
- Based on teachers' knowledge of student's **ability and attitude** in learning



Out of stream subject

Choose subjects in N(T) stream in Subject option student portal by **24 October 2024**.

Offer letter will be given by school to offer Out-of-stream (OSS) subject at higher level for eligible students after school's promotion exercise.



Subject option exercise

1. Students will submit their **confirmed and final subject choices** by **24 October 2024, 5 pm** via Subject Option Student Portal.
2. Choices should be made carefully, endorsed with both parent's and student's signatures. There should be **no change after submission**.
3. Upon release of results on 5 Nov 2024, 12 noon, students and parents may proceed to purchase subject materials for 2025.
