<p>Objectives:</p> <p><u>Mission</u> To create a Christ-centred school community where all work together for the promotion of truth, justice, freedom and love, with special reference to the needs of persons who are disadvantaged in any way.</p> <p><u>Vision</u> We are a community of leaders and learners for God and for others.</p>	<p>Programs/Activities:</p> <p><u>School's Distinctive Programme 1: Applied Learning Programme - Education For Life (ALP-EFL) – Developing Portable Skills through and for Real World Problem Solving:</u> The school has identified and streamlined our Applied Learning platforms with curriculum integration across respective subjects (Lower Secondary Science, History, Geography and Social Studies) in our school. We have also mapped the 21st century standards and benchmarks to these respective subjects' Scheme of Work across levels and streams to ensure that key 21st century skills are explicitly developed through the ALP. We continue to leverage our ALP with partnerships, in order to expose our students to real world authentic experiences and skillsets needed for the world of work, and to guide them towards post-secondary educational and careers pathways.</p> <p><u>School's Distinctive Programme 2: Learning for Life Programme (LLP) – Developing Self-Directed, Confident and Resilient Leaders, learners and Ladies through Sports and Hockey:</u> The school's LLP provides students with the knowledge (Awareness as a Leader), skills (Actions as a Leader) and values (Attitudes as a Lady) for and through Sports, to equip students with the ability and inclination to lead an active, healthy lifestyle even after they leave school. Through our LLP, students are given opportunities to learn and to be developed into confident leaders and ladies to lead and advocate for Sports. At the same time, students will hone their team building skills, self-management and leadership skills and to build resilience in their character.</p> <p><u>Student Leadership Programme (SLP):</u> The SLP adopts a 2-tier developmental approach via Tier 1: Leadership development for all Theresians and Tier 2: Leadership for Theresian Student Leaders. School values and social emotional competencies are incorporated in the SLP. In the enactment of Tier 2, a 3-module SLP is deployed. These 3 modules (Module 1 - Leadership through Experiential Learning; Module 2 - Leadership in Society and Module 3 - Leadership through Service) are situational in nature and cover slightly different objectives. Modules 1 and 2 are conducted over a 2-year cycle while Module 3 is conducted annually. Each year, about 250 students benefit from Modules 1 and 2.</p>
